## ESTIMATED COSTS FOR EBDC'S DANCE COMPANY TEAM:

*These are ONLY estimated costs; sometimes unexpected costs do arise throughout the season.

- Warm ups (jacket, pants \& backpack): \$175 *subject to change
- Costumes: \$250-\$350, per costume
- Performance Gear: \$150+ TBA
- Team Jewelry: \$30
- Choreography Fees: $\$ 350 /$ per routine *subject to change
- Competition entry fees: Range from \$65+/per Competition
- Monthly Tuition starting Aug.-May: Ranges from \$135-\$255+ *Based on how many
classes dancer takes per week


## COMPETITIONS \& PERFORMANCES:

Starting in October, your dancer will be expected to attend at least one weekend event per month. We are doing 4 to 5 competitions, performing at local festivals, Half time at a Warrior's game (must audition to participate) as well as Nationals that will take place in Southern California next summer. *Dates are subject to change

## TEAM MANDATORY SUMMER WORKSHOPS:

Mandatory Ballet, Jazz, Tap and Hip Hop Intensives will be required towards the end of June/early July. If auditioning for Team, dancers will be required to take a 1 week summer intensive in the same disciplines they apply for on their Audition Application. (Audition Application will be filled out at time of Audition) day. If dancers do not take Summer Dance Workshops, they will not be placed on Team- no exceptions.

## MANDATORY CHOREOGRAPHY AGREEMENT:

Dancers will not necessarily have to be available all days of their designated choreography weeks, as they will be split up between the different teams in each age group. Mandatory Team Choreography dates for all 2024-2025 teams will begin August 1st. If dancers do not attend their Choreography Session, they can not stay on Team. No Exceptions! Dancers will be charged choreography fees per routine during the Choreography Session in August.

## WARM-UPS:

We will be ordering them for the new team warmups; cost is tba

## COSTUME COSTS:

The Company Team dances compete and are performed much more often than our Recital dances. Thus, the cost is higher than what is found at a recreational level. The cost starting per costume will range from $\$ 100-\$ 350$, per routine *subject to change. This does not always include the cost of accessories, shoes, tights, jewelry or make-up. Dancers will also be required to purchase some M.A.C. Cosmetics pieces as well as drug store makeup pieces.
